# AN ORDINANCE TO SET THE SALARIES OF THE ELECTED OFFICIALS, CITY OF WEST LAFAYETTE, INDIANA, FOR THE YEAR 2016

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST LAFAYETTE, INDIANA:

#### SECTION 1. Purpose

That the purpose of this ordinance is to set the salaries of all elected officials for the year 2016. (I.C. 36-4-7-2)

#### SECTION 2. Fixed Salaries

That the total salary to be paid to each named elected official for the year 2016 shall be:
