

RESOLUTION NO. 21-16

A RESOLUTION CONDEMNING THE PLACING OF FASCIST, WHITE SUPREMACIST POSTERS ON THE CAMPUS OF PURDUE UNIVERSITY

WHEREAS, Purdue University is an integral part of West Lafayette and Purdue University community members are essential contributors to the rich diversity of the West Lafayette community; and

WHEREAS, Fascist, White Supremacist posters placed on the Purdue University campus are intentionally reminiscent of National Socialist propaganda and therefore threaten multiple groups of people with hatred, discrimination, and violence

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of West Lafayette, Indiana, that while recognizing the right to freedom of expression, the Common Council unequivocally and in the strongest terms condemns the placing of Fascist, White Supremacist posters on the campus of Purdue University and rejects the message of intolerance that threatens the diverse members of the West Lafayette community.


