ORDINANCE NO. 10-2023

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING THE USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS IN CERTAIN PUBLIC PLACES

WHEREAS, the City of West Lafayette is authorized by I.C. §7.1-5-12-13 to adopt an ordinance more restrictive than I.C. 7.1-5-12 et. seq.

WHEREAS, pursuant to I.C. §7.1-5-12-4, smoking is prohibited in the area within eight (8) feet of a public entrance to a public place or a place of employment.

WHEREAS, the City of West Lafayette wishes to protect its citizens from the dangers of second hand smoke.

WHEREAS, to provide for and promote the health and safety of its citizens and protect them from the dangers of secondhand smoke, the City now desires to increase the distance where smoking is prohibited from eight (8) feet to fifteen (15) feet.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST LAFAYETTE that the following section to be added to the West Lafayette City Code Chapter 16, Article II, Section 16-21(a) (addition is in **bold**) as follows:

Sec. 16-21. – Prohibition in public places.

- (a) Smoking shall be prohibited in the following public places and other public places similarly situated, including, but not limited to, the following areas:
 - (16) the area within fifteen (15) feet of a public entrance to:
 - (A) a public place; or
 - (B) a place of employment.
