# CITY OF WEST LAFAYETTE COMMON COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES OCTOBER 13, 2014

The Common Council of the City of West Lafayette, Indiana, met in Room 106 at the Morton Community Center on October 13, 2014, at the hour of 6:30 p.m.

Mayor Dennis read Ordinance No. 32-14 (Amended) by title only.

Councilor Keen moved for passage of Ordinance No. 32-14 (Amended) on second and final reading, and that the vote be by roll call. The motion was seconded by Councilor Burch.

Clerk-Treasurer Rhodes noted that this ordinance as amended contains the final map and the listing of census blocks, and City Attorney Associate Williams confirmed that.

The Council members discussed that the City has not received a report from the Census Bureau.

Councilor Hunt stated that she appreciates that this as a bipartisan effort and everyone working on this together, particularly Councilors Dietrich and DeBoer.

Mayor Dennis stated that he shares the same sentiment and said that the Councilors did an amazing job.
