

**ORDINANCE NO. 02-2024 (Amended)**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WEST LAFAYETTE TRAFFIC COMMISSION (SEC. 38-98) TO MODIFY THE MEMBERSHIP QUALIFICATIONS FOR CITIZEN REPRESENTATIVES**

WHEREAS, the Traffic Commission established by West Lafayette Code Sec. 38-98(2)a provides that the Common Council will appoint “One representative from each of the six council districts of the City”; and

WHEREAS, it has been difficult to always find a citizen representative from each of the six Council districts of the City, which has caused some seats to be unfilled for significant periods of time, and which interferes with the effective operation of the Traffic Commission; and

WHEREAS, each of the six Council districts should have a citizen representative whenever reasonably possible.

NOW THEREFORE be it Ordained that West Lafayette City Code Sec. 38-98(2)a is hereby deleted, and the following bold language is inserted in complete substitution therefor:

**Each representative shall be a citizen of the City with preference being given to appointments which result in a citizen representative residing in each of the six city council districts.**
