

RESOLUTION NO. 27-22

**A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE OPIOID-UNRESTRICTED FUND AND THE
OPIOID-RESTRICTED FUND**

Whereas, the City of West Lafayette is scheduled to receive approximately \$600,000 Opioids Litigation as set forth in Indiana Code 4-6-15, and

Whereas, Indiana Code 4-6-15 has placed spending restrictions on a portion of those funds, and

Whereas, the City of West Lafayette desires to monitor and track receipts & expenses pertaining to the Opioid Settlement, and

Whereas, the Common Council may establish whatever funds it deems necessary to operate the City of West Lafayette.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST LAFAYETTE, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City of West Lafayette establishes Opioid-Unrestricted Fund (#2256) & Opioid-Restricted Fund (#2257), per guidance from the Indiana State Board of Accounts, to track and monitor receipts & expenses that are entrusted to the City.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and signing by the Mayor.


