**A RESOLUTION TO PRESCRIBE SARS-COV-2
VACCINATION FOR CITY ELECTED OFFICIALS**

WHEREAS, it has been one year since the COVID-19 pandemic manifested in the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, there have been more than four-hundred-thousand deaths from COVID-19 in the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, there exist vaccines against SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19, that are safe and effective at preventing COVID-19 disease; and

WHEREAS, it is essential that elected officials lead by example;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST LAFAYETTE, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION 1. All elected officials of the City of West Lafayette are strongly urged to receive one of the approved vaccines against SARS-CoV-2 within thirty days of being eligible to be vaccinated, contingent upon the availability of the vaccine.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall expire and be of no further force or effect on and after December 31, 2023.


