

**RESOLUTION NO. 08-21****A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE WEST LAFAYETTE COMMUNITY  
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT 2019  
ONE-YEAR ANNUAL ACTION PLAN (PART 3)**

**WHEREAS**, the City of West Lafayette City Council adopted Resolution No. 06-19, approving the West Lafayette Community Development Block Grant one-year Action Plan for Program Year 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of West Lafayette City Council re-appropriated funds from the 2019 CDBG Action Plan per Resolution 09-20;

**WHEREAS**, the City of West Lafayette has been awarded a total of \$469,008.00 of CDBG-CV funding through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act to assist the City with its response to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, the CDBG Mayor's Advisory Boards reviewed applications for CDBG-CV funding and held a public hearing on April 13, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, this application will be approved by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Common Council of the City of West Lafayette, Indiana, approves the programs listed hereunder, and the applications for this federal assistance.
