

RESOLUTION NO. 21-21

A RESOLUTION TO OVERRIDE MAYORAL VETO OF ORDINANCE NO. 15-21 (AMENDED): AN ORDINANCE BANNING GOVERNMENT USE OF FACIAL-RECOGNITION SURVEILLANCE TECHNOLOGY

WHEREAS, On November 1, 2021, the West Lafayette Common Council passed Ordinance No. 15-21 (Amended): An Ordinance Banning Government Use of Facial-Recognition Surveillance Technology; and

WHEREAS, On November 2, 2021, Mayor John Dennis vetoed such Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, A Mayoral veto may be overridden by a two-thirds vote of the Council, per West Lafayette City Code, Sec. 2-131 (8) and Indiana statute.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST LAFAYETTE, INDIANA that the Mayoral veto of Ordinance No. 15-21 (Amended) is overridden.
